This new poster reflects our on-going efforts to make the Koestler Awards more accessible by telling the story of the Awards through illustrations and by including some translations of the words 'art, music and writing competition' done by our entrants and supporters. We are really proud of this new resource and we hope that you will love it as much as we do!

We would be very grateful if you could help us promote the Awards by displaying one of these posters on your wing and telling someone who doesn't know about Koestler how to get involved.
