Idea #24: Draw with Words

People often think of drawing and writing as two separate ways of expressing themselves. For this task, have a go at combining the two!

Can you make an image entirely out of words? Don't use any lines or shading (although you might like to start with some basic guidelines) and just use words to build the image.




Consider:

- How do the image and the words relate?
- Are the words your own or are they taken from somewhere else?
- Do you use whole paragraphs of text or just repeat a single word over and over again?
- Can you change the size, weight and shape of your writing to create different tones and textures in your image?

Have a look at the image on the other side of this sheet. It is entirely made up of words! The image shows the artist sat in his cell reading feedback he received from members of the public after one of his works was exhibited by Koestler at the Southbank Centre, London. The words he's used to make the image are all quotes from his feedback!
