January 2022

This task was set by Koestler Award winner, exhibited artist and former mentee, Ghost 13.

My Story

From a young age I've always enjoyed drawing, copying and tracing Looney Toons and Disney cartoon characters. Later, in my teens, I would be influenced by hip hop music and its culture inspired by graffiti in particular with its lettering and imagery.

Finding myself incarcerated I relied on art to help pass my time, providing me with a platform to help my imagination to escape. I discovered Koestler Arts and the great work they do via a prison art tutor. Making work to be submitted to the Koestler Awards gave me direction and a purpose.

Upon release I was fortunate to be matched with a Koestler Mentor. The feedback and affirmation I received for my work helped give me confidence to go through uni to gain my Ba Hons 1st Class Degree in Contemporary Art. I worked for 3 years after graduating as a full-time proffesional tattoo artist and now I am a freelance artist/illustrator specialising in murals and signage.





The Task: Design an alphabet to use in your own artworks or use it as a blueprint to develop

your own fonts.

You Will Need: Paper, pencil, possibly a ruler (edge of a book works)


Using a pencil lightly mark out 5 rows of 5 boxes (6 boxes last row) this will be the 26 letters of your alphabet. Using a ruler/the edge of a book will help your letters appear neat and uniform but free hand works too - it will give your letters a looser style.



Lightly with a pencil, make basic markings for your letters' characteristics using the individual boxes as a guide for each letter.



Refine your letters, outlining straight edges and/or rounding off edges as required by each letter. Once done you now have a basic alphabet blueprint.



This is ready for you you to use as a template for calligraphy/word art. Putting plain paper over your alphabet sheet you can trace the letters you need using the sun's light from your window. If you want to develop it and make more fonts, ask a prison officer to photocopy it for you so you can work on to it, or just trace multiple sheets by hand.

Why not add drawings to your lettering? Try mixing styles together, or use different fonts. Try overlapping your letters, use bubble writing, make it 3D with shadows, try lowercase alphabets, add numbers, colour etc. Write any names, sayings, quotes. Have fun with it.
