
## My Story

Altogether I won over a hundred Awards for my poetry, short stories, a novel, paintings in different mediums, prison magazines, and even rap lyrics. I was given a mentor for my visual art when I was released which was invaluable.

Since then, I have had work exhibited all over the country and seen my plays performed in several wellknown venues. I also teach Creative Writing in a hostel every week. I am a member of three drama groups and work part time as a Creative Collaborator at a theatre.

## My Task: Dream Destination

Imagine that you are away on a trip or holiday at your dream destination - it could be anywhere and with anyone you'd like. Maybe an ideal holiday or one you remember from the past, maybe outer space, the 1920s, the distant future... it's up to you!

Draw or paint this dream destination on a piece of paper as if it's the front of a postcard you'd send back to family or friends.





On the back of the postcard, write a short passage or poem describing your trip - think about the sights, sounds, tastes, feelings and smells you'd experience in your chosen destination. Let your reader know about how you've been relaxing or the exciting adventures you've been on. Take them with you on your imaginary journey through your writing!
